We are rapidly approaching the end of 2014 and it is time to look back at the year that has passed. The year would most definitely take pride of place in any history book written about the company. We are up and running at our new premises in Hillerstorp and can already see ROI in the shape of improved internal flows and increased production efficiency.

The 'Health Situation' at Axelent

General terms like this seldom does not create headlines. Instead, I will present some figures that speak for themselves about the 'health situation' at Axelent.

The figures are from October 2014, the best month of the year from a growth perspective.

We delivered 2,305 orders, corresponding to 712,000 kg. Converted into mesh walls, that is a total of 52,785.

Born Global, Act Global

Despite a generally low growth rate in Europe, Axelent has improved by roughly 10 per cent on the previous year and also broke its global sales record in October.

We are now market leader in Germany and had our market position confirmed in a positive way at the Motek International Trade Fair in Stuttgart in October. Axelent GmbH also passed its dream boundary for new orders during the same month. Other Axelent countries are following the same pattern.

Growth both in France and in Hillerstorp

Looking ahead, things look very bright. A good year is always a good springboard for the coming year. Next year we will be building new premises in France, our greatest investment in BMI Axelent's history. We are also planning continued expansion here in Hillerstorp.


A round tour of the plant

has seen us grow on existing and new markets. In addition, our new X5 quick joining, which facilitates quicker and more cost-effective installations, has received positive feedback from the market.



The meeting discussed the prospects of continued development of the international standard for the preparation of instructions for use, IEC 82079-1. The standard is also a European standard and is considered the most important basis for assessing the quality of instruction handbooks and manuals. Matthias Schulz, senior safety consultant at Axelent in Germany, took part along with a delegation from German Tekom.

Matthias also held a lecture on the new EU directive for EMC and low voltage equipment, which now contains demands on manuals and instruction handbooks that will come into force on 20 April 2016.
